#### **Pool Hours**

Monday -Friday

- Open Swim 1pm-5pm/6pm-8pm
- Lap Swim (18 and older) 5pm-6pm

#### Saturday/Sunday

Open Swim 1pm-6pm

### Admission

- Daily Admission (5 years and older) \$2.00
- Children under 5 are free with a paid adult.
- Children under 5 need to be within arm's length of supervising person.
- Family Pass (immediate family only) \$70
- Individual Pass \$40
- Senior Citizen \$25

### **General Rules**

- All swimmers must check in and shower off before swimming.
- All swimmers under age 18 are to get out of the pool at rest breaks.
- NO RUNNING within the gated area.

#### Safety Disclaimer

 Any swimmer engaging in an activity that is determined to be dangerous or otherwise detrimental to the swimmer or any other patrons of the pool may be asked to stop the activity and may result in the swimmer(s) being asked to leave the Arapahoe Plunge.

### **Flotation Devices**

- Floatation devices are permitted in the pool if they are not visibly soiled and do not obstruct the view of the lifeguards. They are not to be used as a substitute for independent swimming. Please rinse your flotation device before use. The pool is not responsible for damage to your flotation device. The manager reserves the right to revoke the use of the flotation device if it is being misused or the pool has high occupancy.
- Baby boats are to be used in the baby and mid pool, by children 3 years and younger. If a parent wishes to take their own child into the deep end, they may do so.

# **Permission to Swim**

- Baby Pool: Intended for small children who cannot swim independently in the mid pool.
- Mid Pool: Intended for swimmers who cannot swim independently in the deep pool.
- **Deep Pool:** is intended for swimmers who can swim the length of the pool, and have permission to dive off the board from the lifeguard. **Parents may take their children to the deep end, however they need to be within an arm length of them at all times.**
- Every year: To swim in the deep pool, a swimmer must have a lifeguard watch them swim one length of the pool without stopping or touching the bottom or the rope. The lifeguard may determine if the swimmer has made a satisfactory attempt.
- **Diving board:** is intended for swimmers that swam the length of the pool. However, parents or lifeguards may take children off the diving board with a manager's permission. Only one person is permitted on the diving board at a time.
